Cultural Corner - July in Sicily

July is Sicily's most popular month for visitors thanks to hot, sunny weather and ideal sea temperatures. Though the average high is 86°F across the island, delightful breezes off the Med make coastal towns a treat at this time of year. Many businesses shut down for an afternoon siesta from 1:30 pm to 4:30 pm, the hottest part of the day, during July and August. Key events include Luglio Musicale in Trapani and Santa Rosalia Festa in Palermo.

Watermelon Granita

- ½ whole seedless watermelon, cut into chunks (no rind)
- 2 whole limes, juiced and zested
- 1/3 cup white sugar



Place half the watermelon, half the lime juice, half the lime zest, and half the sugar in a blender. Process until smooth, then pour into a separate bowl.

Repeat with other half of ingredients. Pour into same bowl as other batch.

Transfer mixture to a 9 x 13 baking dish. Freeze for two or three hours, then begin the process of lightly scraping the top, frozen layer. Return pan to freezer with the shaved ice on top; remove a couple of hours later and continue scraping. Repeat the occasional scraping process until the entire mixture is shaved. Store, covered in plastic wrap, until serving.

Serve in pretty glasses with a twist of lime.
