Mother's Day in Sicily

May is the month for Mother's Day celebrations both in Sicily and in America. Celebrated as Festa della Mamma in Italy, Mother's Day is always celebrated on the second Sunday in May, the same date as in America. The first official Mother's Day celebration in Italy did not take place until 1957 in the city of Assisi. It was here that a priest, Father Otello Migliosi, from the village of Tordibetto, promoted this special day.

Mothers in Sicily are generally considered to be dominant figures regardless of whether they work outside the home or not. The Sicilian mother is basically in charge of all of facets of domestic life. Sicilians recognize their mother as the one person who is credited with holding the family together. At the same time a Sicilian mother knows that she can count on her family in times of need. She is highly respected in the Italian culture.

In Sicily, Mother's Day is not so much a commercial holiday as it is a special day to spend with mamma. Many Sicilians opt to make their mothers a breakfast and later take them out to eat lunch or dinner at a restaurant to give mamma a rest from cooking. Festa della Mamma has become the most popular day for restaurants in Sicily. Usually a gift is part of the celebration, with a focus on the family spending time together. Children bring fresh flowers (often roses) and gifts to their mothers, and there's an emphasis on writing poems as a way of showing appreciation. In schools they often write these little poesie dedicated to la mamma and bring them home.

Here is a popular choice for breakfast on Festa della Mamma:

Coffee Granita

3 cups strong, hot brewed coffee3/4 cup sugar2 teaspoons coffee liqueur, such as Tia Maria1 teaspoon pure vanilla extractWhipped Cream



Instructions:

Combine the coffee, sugar, coffee liqueur, and vanilla and stir until the sugar dissolves. Pour the mixture into a 9×13 -inch pan. Let the mixture cool completely to room temperature before putting it into the freezer in a shallow metal or glass dish. Placethe pan in the freezer for 1 hour, until the mixture starts to become slushy around the edges. Rake the mixture with a dinner fork to break up the crystals and place the pan back in the freezer. Every 30 minutes, rake the mixture, until it is completely frozen and granular throughout. Wrap well and keep frozen for a few hours, until ready to serve. Spoon the granita into stemmed glasses and top with a dollop of whipped cream. Top with some shaved chocolate and/or ground cinnamon Serve immediately.
