PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

SOS Brothers-

I believe there is some confusion / misunderstanding about a motion that was made at one of our meetings and I want to be extremely clear what occurred.

At the November regular meeting a member made a motion to "Have dessert at every meeting" which was seconded and voted on. After this meeting it was pointed out that this motion and vote was against our By-Laws and therefore it was Null and Void per Rule 47 of the Roberts Rules of Order. I invite the member who made the original motion to make the motion again as a By-Law change and it will be heard. I have attached Rule 47 from the Roberts Rules of Order below:



47. Votes that are Null and Void even if Unanimous. No motion is in order that conflicts with the laws of the nation, or state, or with the assembly's constitution or by-laws, and if such a motion is adopted, even by a unanimous vote, it is null and void. No rule that conflicts with a rule of a higher order is of any authority; thus, a by-law providing for the suspension by general consent of an article of the constitution would be null and void; so, the general parliamentary rule allowing a two-thirds vote to amend the by-laws after due notice, is only in force when the by-laws are silent on the subject.


This club is run by the membership and any member in good standing has a right to make a motion. The board of directors and officers serve the club at the direction of the members.





Holy Week -

The Holy Week Traditions in Sicily are an incredible combination of religious festivals with archaic celebrations of the rebirth of nature, of spring over winter, of life over death. They are mostly the legacy of the 17th century Spanish domination of the island, and still bear a close resemblance to current Easter traditions in southern Spain.

A multitude of ancient rituals take place in various towns and villages around the island. Solemn processions and reenactments of the passion of Christ, culminate in the joyful celebrations of Easter Sunday



with fireworks,

doves, flowers and cheerful music accompanying the statue of the risen Christ meeting with that of the Madonna for the so called "'ncuontru" (encounter - the moment they meet).

After the procession, people wish each other "Buona Pasqua" (Happy Easter) and go back home to share a traditional meal with the rest of the family. Both devotees and tourists attend events organized by the "confraternite" (the brotherhoods) to reenact the last days of Jesus' life until the resurrection on Easter Sunday.


