





From Sicilian Accademy—Text by Ignazio Corrao

Sicilian (u sicilianu) is not a dialect but a LANGUAGE, and it is not a language that derives from Italian but, like Italian itself, derives directly from vulgar Latin. Sicilian represents the first Italian literary language, already in the first half of the thirteenth century, in the context of the Sicilian School.

UNESCO recognizes the status of "mother tongue" of the Sicilian language and classifies it among the "vulnerable" European languages. Sicilians are described as bilingual, with the difference that Sicilian is handed down in the family and on the street almost in a clandestine way (and we



are often ashamed to speak it too), while Italian is imposed in schools, institutions and in any office public (and even private).

Few, especially a few Sicilians, understand that Sicilian is an extraordinary language, spoken by over 5 million people around the world, which should be studied, preserved, protected and to be deeply proud of. Instead, there has been a violent repression of pre-existing cultures and even the tendency is to pass as a hoax and ignorant the one who speaks their own language or that does not speak Italian. It seems shocking to me that Sicilian is not spoken in the Sicilian Regional Assembly (on the contrary, Sicilian deputies often speak very bad Italian in the assembly, while I have heard in Sardinia and Corsica speak their own languages in the regional assemblies (Not to mention Spain). Almost all Sicilians are able to speak and understand it, but we are essentially illiterate, unable to write or read it well because we have been basically prevented from doing so.




